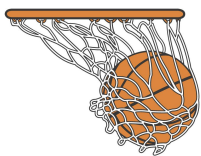

The Habit of The Month for January is "Think Win-Win". We will also be working as a school to set a school wide, classroom, and personal WIG. A WIG is a **WILDLY IMPORTANT GOAL**. Students will learn about goal setting, establishing a plan to achieve their goal, identifying an accountability partner, and tracking progress towards their goal.
